2) Self-importance (v.3)

- The opposite of 'vain conceit' is humility. *'In humility consider others better than yourselves'* (v.3)

- Not more gifted or morally better, but more important

3) Self-centredness (v.4)

- The Christian life should change our focus – look to interests of others
- How do we treat our family, our neighbours, our friends, our colleagues, members of our church?
- Who is at the centre of our conversations, thoughts, prayers?

(vv. 5–11)

Probably an early Christian hymn

The mind of Christ displays the opposite of selfish ambition, self-importance and self-centredness

1) Let go his natural status (v.6)

- Exchanged the status of God for that of man
