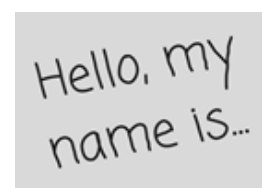

Preparation of The New Electoral Roll - 2019

The compiling of the new Electoral Roll for St Mary's and St John's will take place during the period of Sunday 3rd February to Sunday 10th March 2019 inclusive.

Every 6 years a new Electoral Roll is prepared and those on the previous roll must re-apply by completing an application form.

Forms of application for enrolment will be available from the Parish Office and in the churches during that period. The application form is also available to download from the Parish website LINK. Signed hard copies must be returned to the Parish Office by no later than Monday 11th March 2019 after which no further changes can be made until after the Annual Parish Church Meeting on Wednesday 3rd April 2019.
