Join us as we take the light of Christ from St Mary's Church around our town and back to our homes



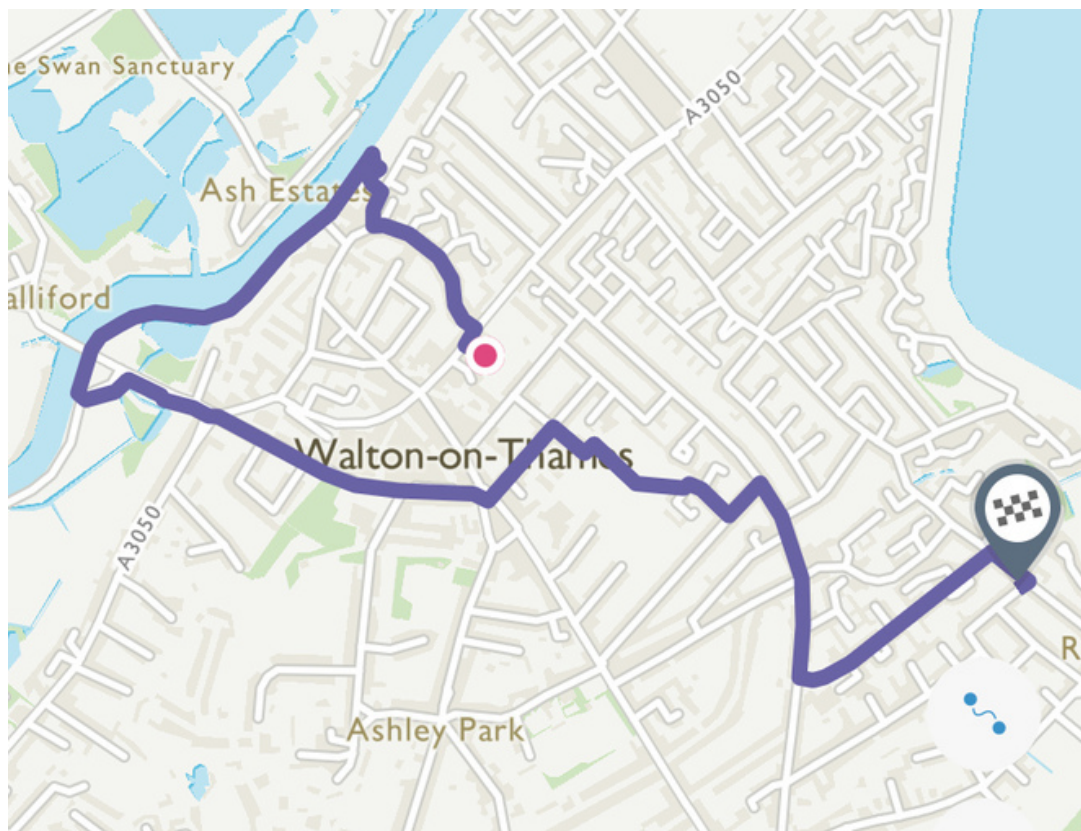

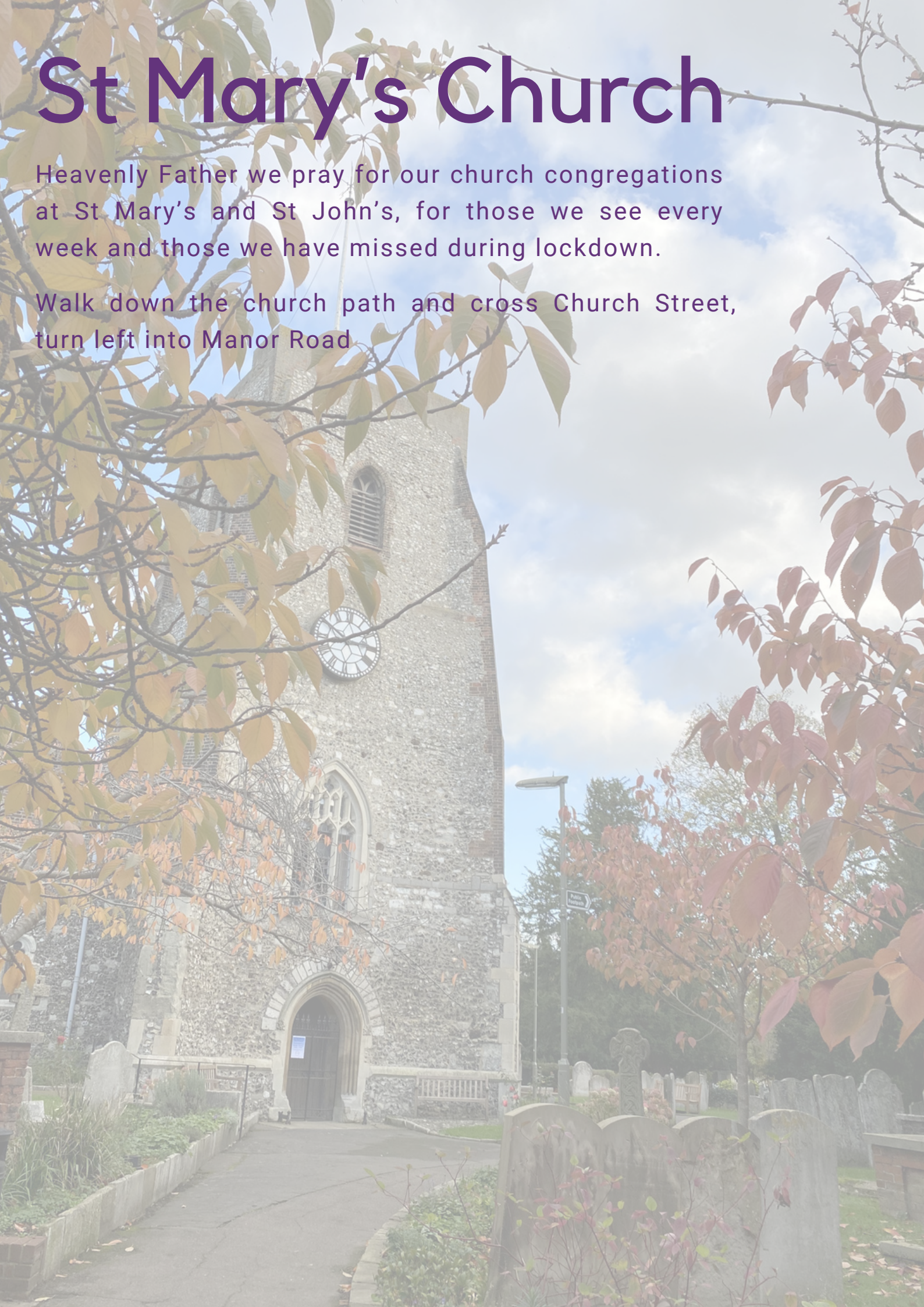

Walk down the church path and cross Church Street, turn left into Manor Road

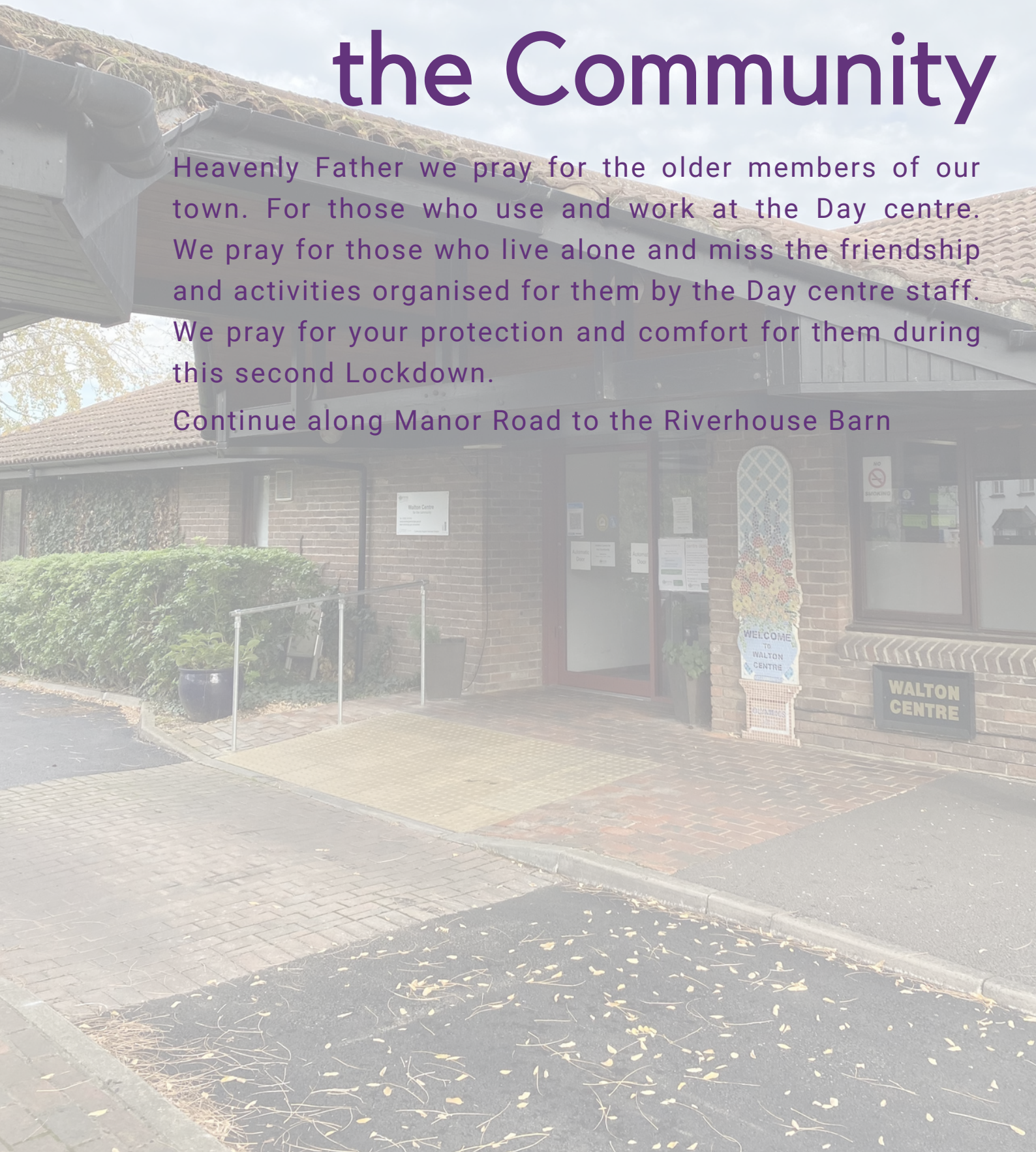




# Walton Centre for the Community

Continue on the tow path towards Walton Bridge









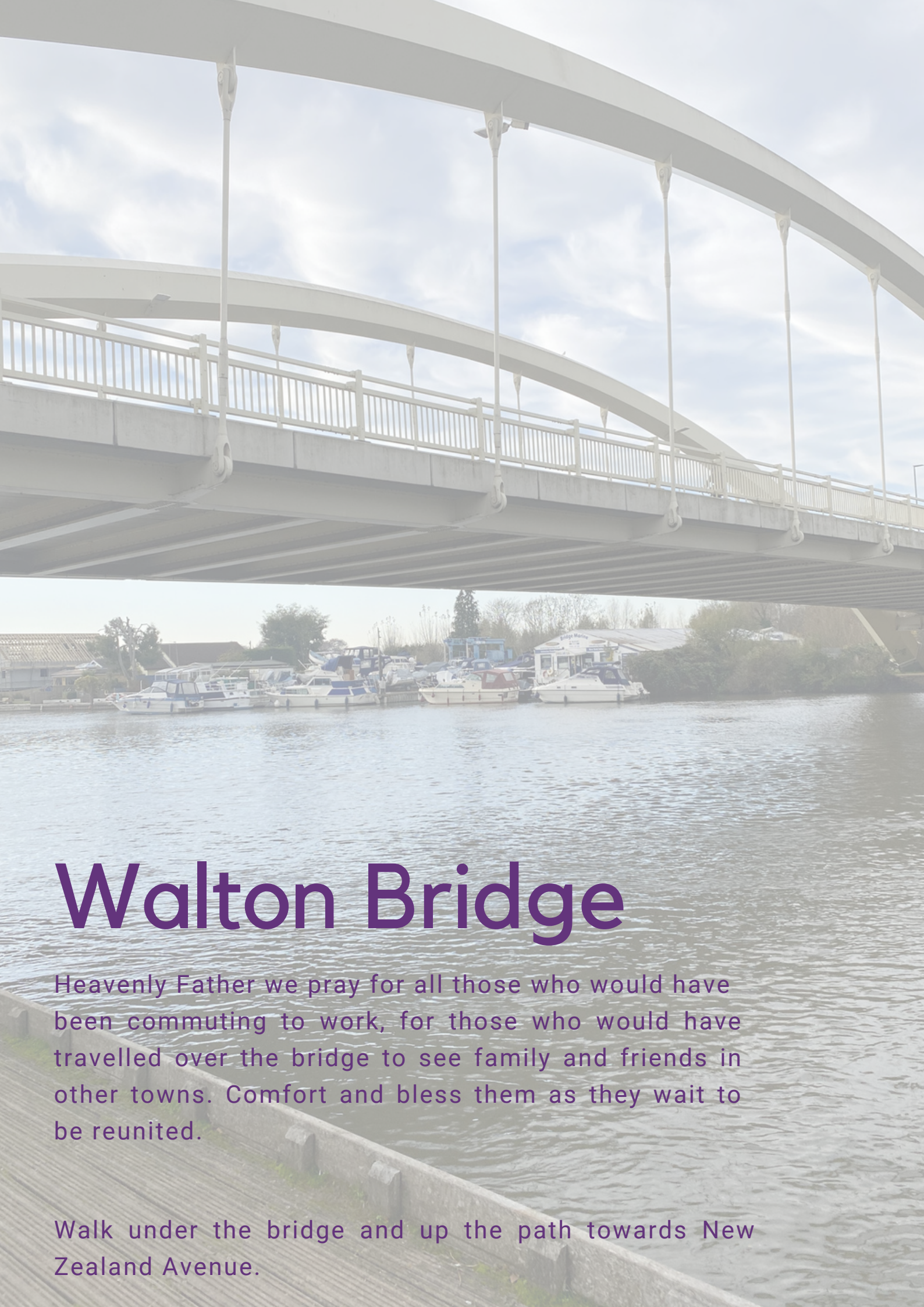
# The Tow Path

# The Heart

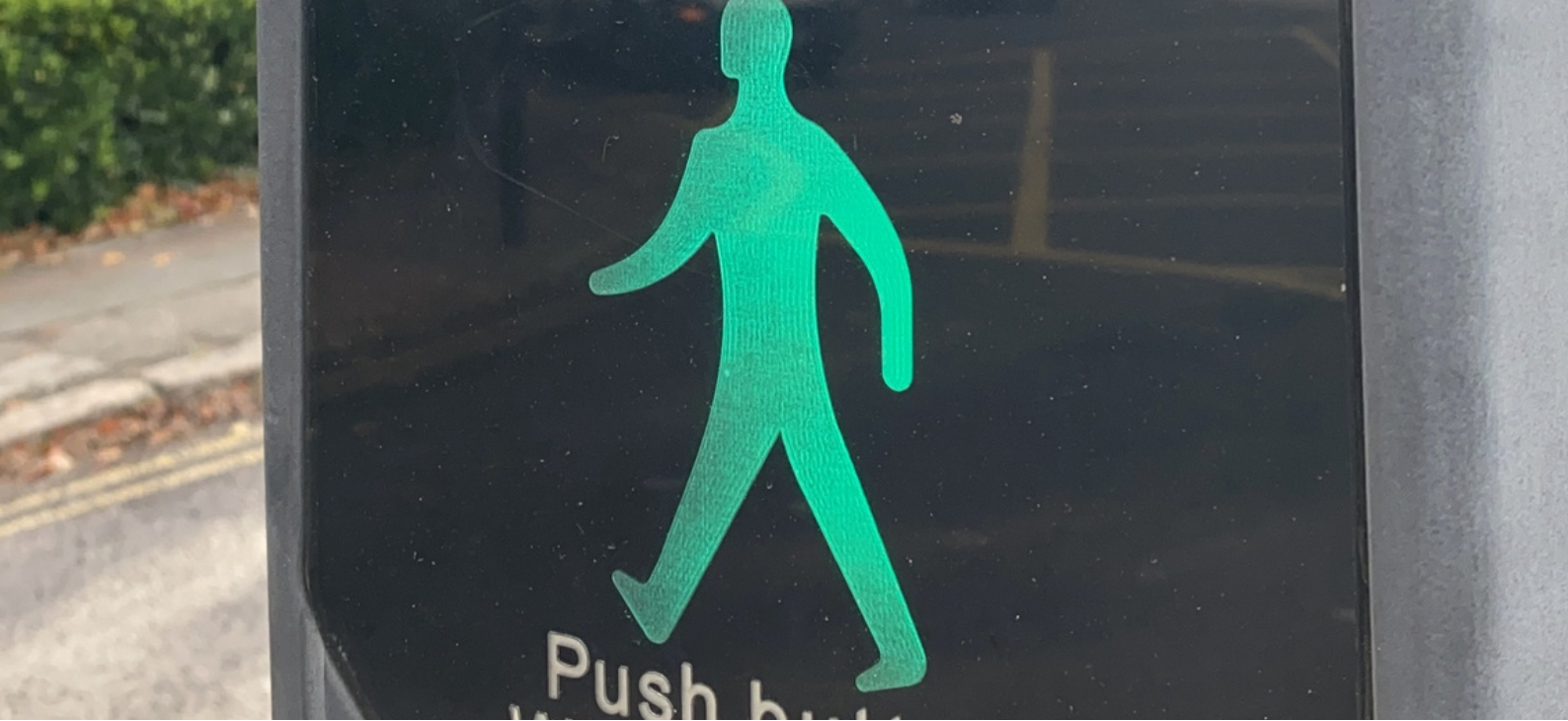

Continue along New Zealand Avenue

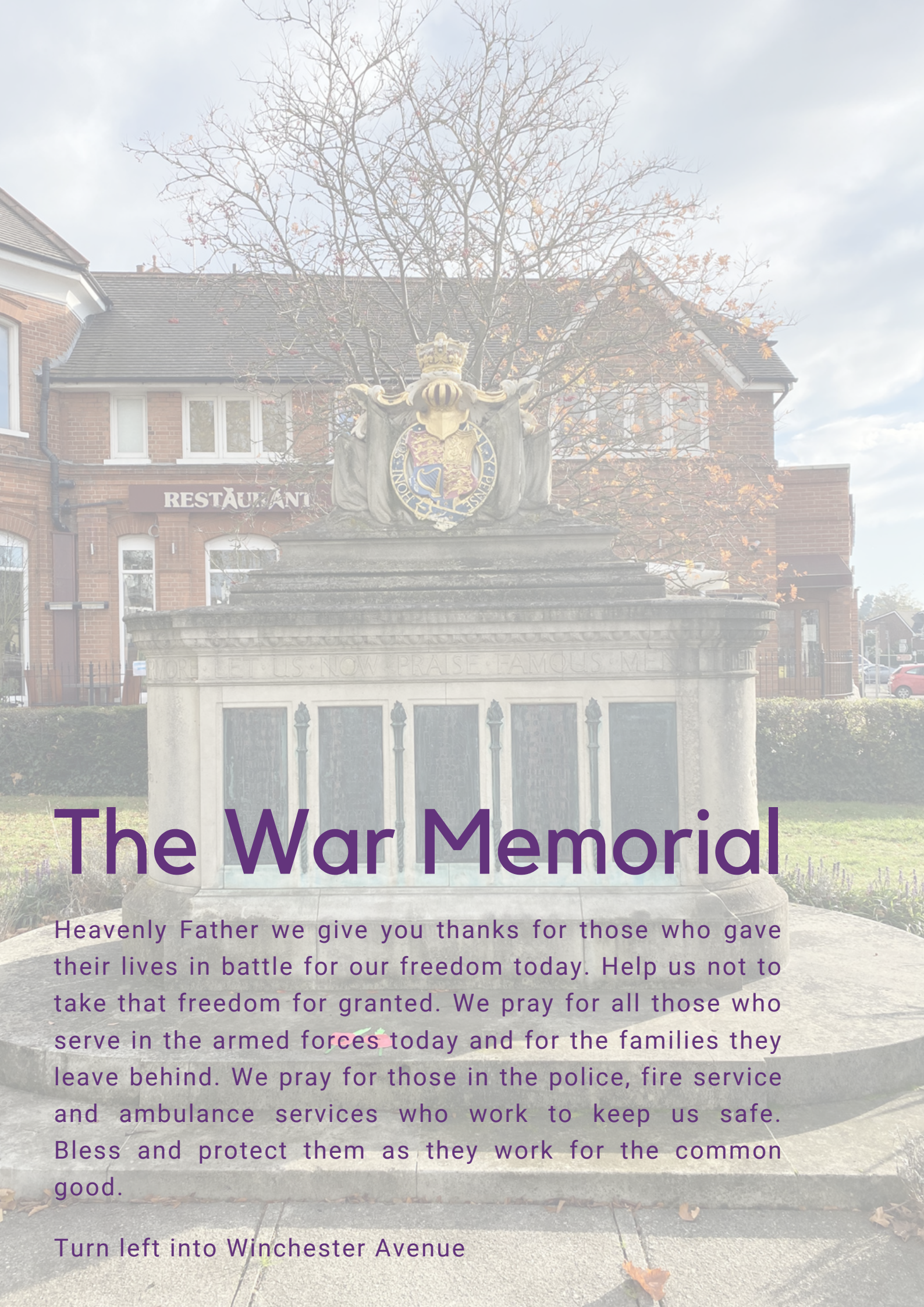
