## STATEMENT OF FAITH

*Minister* Friends, if you believe in this Easter message, let us declare together our faith in the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ

*Minister* Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

**All** I believe in God, the Father almighty,  
creator of heaven and earth.

*Minister* Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ?

**All** I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the Virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried;  
he descended to the dead.  
On the third day he rose again;  
he ascended into heaven,  
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,
