

Holding on to Truth

March 2024

Dear Friends,

"In a world of deep fakes and disinformation, Jesus is the truth".

My Lent book is John Mark Comer "live no lies" and his working theory is that as followers of Jesus, we are at war with the world, the flesh, and the devil.

In a world of deep fakes and disinformation, he wants to expose the root of the deception we find all around us as the devil and encourage Christians to hold onto the truth. He says: "The nation of the United States is more divided than it's been since the Civil War, and the last thing we need is more fuel on the fire. He wants to name the felt experience of following Jesus in this cultural moment, and he says he

just can't find a better description than it feels like a war for the soul. His working theory is, as followers of Jesus, we are at war with the world, the flesh, and the devil. But our war against the three enemies of the soul is not a war of guns and bombs. It's not against other people at all. It's a war on lies. And the problem is less that we tell lies and more that we live them; we let false narratives about reality into our bodies, and they wreak havoc in our souls."

Jesus called the devil "the father of lies." Translation: the original point of deception. Then Jesus has that great line about how "when he lies, he speaks his native language." So, lies are unreality; Truth is reality.

John Mark Comer says "Every day can feel like war on our souls. A spiritual assault on our faith. A fight to just stay saved or at least to stay orthodox, to stay faithful to Jesus, and to stay sane, much less to stay happy and at peace. When you're a cognitive minority under constant pressure to assimilate, you can't help but think, am I crazy to believe what I believe? To live how I live?"

Now, I know more about deep fakes from TV drama than from research, but, it's scary; the idea that people can create Deep fakes - constructed videos of people saying things which they never said and may not even agree with ... where is this going? And where does this end.? We live in an age of "Disinformation."

Republican Senator Jeff Flake said the year Donald Trump was elected "was a year which saw the truth - objective, empirical, evidence-based truth - more battered and abused than any other in the history of our country, at the hands of the most powerful figure in our government."

Comer says "Our new environment is one in which a battle is raging between truth and lies, and truth is losing. Disinformation - or in the language of Scripture, deception - is at the root of almost every single problem we face in our society and our souls."

In this cultural moment of 'truth decay', I find Jesus's teachings on the devil and lies more plausible, insightful, and compelling than ever before. Jesus and the apostles warn us over and over again of the dangers of lies, deception, false doctrine, and false teachers, who are wolves in sheep's clothing. Do not be deceived. Jesus is the way the truth and the life. Let's hold onto that truth.

Fusion Spain
